Public Safety Dive Tender Operations Course

CLASS is Limited to 16 Students

This course is designed to introduce the public safety professional to the ERDI Tender skills necessary to participate in public safety diving operations in a non-diving roll. Successful completion results in the ERDI Tender Operations Level Certification.

The course will use self-study, classroom sessions, and practical applications in the pool.

This program will not include any open water dives, which may be offered as part of a Technician program in the future.

Pre-Requisites: Minimum age is 18; CPR 1st or equivalent;

Swim Test:

1. 200 metre non-stop swim without aids
2. 100 metre non-stop buddy tow in PFD
3. 10 minute survival-float

Required Equipment: USCG approved personal floatation device (PFD), Cutting tools: 1 primary, 1 backup; Rescue signals: audio and visual; Gloves: latex and work.

Pike County Training Center will provide the textbook, on loan, for use in the class.

Class cost is \$195
